



Iredell-Statesville Board of Education to Hold Public Hearing
Community Invited to Weigh In on Board of Education Redistricting

Statesville, NC - At a called board meeting held on Wednesday, September 30th at the Career Academy and Technical School, members of the board of education reviewed three alternative redistricting maps. The motion was made and passed (5-2) to eliminate Alternative Map 1 and to have Alternative Map 2 and Alternative Map 3 go before the public for a hearing on Monday, October 4, 2021.

It is common practice to redistrict electoral districts every ten years, following the completion of the census. The goal of electoral redistricting is to maintain compliance with one-person/one vote.

Members of the public are invited to attend the formal hearing at 5:00 p.m. on Monday, October 4, 2021, in the conference room at the Career Academy and Technical School. Those wishing to make a comment will be able to sign up on the clipboard outside of the room from 4:30 to 5:00 p.m. This public comment section will only be held for those wishing to speak regarding redistricting the electoral districts for the Iredell-Statesville Board of Education. Regular public comment will be held at the October monthly meeting held on October 11, 2021.
